A RESOLUTION

Offered by MR. BARTON

Be it resolved by the Committee on Energy and Commerce, that upon the adoption of this Resolution, the Chairman of the Committee on Energy and Commerce, with the concurrence of the Ranking Minority Member, may authorize and issue subpoenas to testify and subpoenas duces tecum to any person or entity in respect of matters involved in, relating to, or arising from the Committee's investigation of the sexual exploitation of children over the Internet including, in particular, to any person or entity in respect of matters involved in, relating to, or arising from the Committee's investigation of the 1998 adoption of Masha Allen, formerly known as Yashenkova Maria Nickolayevna, Maria Mancuso, and Masha Mancuso, from Russia by Matthew A. Mancuso.

This Resolution is adopted pursuant to Rule XI, clause 2(m)(1) and (3) of the Rules of the U.S. House of Representatives.

The powers set forth by this resolution will expire upon the dissolution of the 109th Congress, *sine die*.
