

John H. Skinner, Ph.D., has been the Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer, of the Solid Waste Association of North America (SWANA), in Silver Spring, Maryland, since August 1996. Prior to August of 1996, Dr. Skinner held the position of Senior Advisor, Industry and Environment Programme, for the United Nations Environment Programme in Paris, France, for a period of four years. He was with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, in Washington, DC, from 1972 through 1992, serving in various capacities, including the position of Deputy Assistant Administrator - Office of R&D (1988-1992). His professional activities include serving as the National Representative to International Solid Waste Association (ISWA), 1996 to present, and President of ISWA, 1992-1996. He also held the position of President for the Institute of Solid Wastes of APWA 1990-1991. He is the recipient of many awards and honors including the Presidential Distinguished Executive Award 1992, the A.J. Barnes Human Resources Leadership Award-EPA 1992, Gold Medal for Exceptional Service-US EPA, the Honorary Fellow-UK Institute of Wastes Management 1994, and a NASA Fellowship- Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI). Dr. Skinner received a Ph.D. in Aeronautical Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI) in 1968, a Masters of Aeronautical Engineering, RPI, in 1966 and a B.S. in Engineering Science from Hofstra University in 1964.
