

SENIOR EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT - GLOBAL POLICY AND EXTERNAL AFFAIRS



MICHAEL O'LEARY, SENIOR EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT, GLOBAL POLICY AND EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, OVERSEES THE DAY-TO-DAY POLICY OPERATION OF THE MPAA'S EFFORTS IN THE UNITED STATES AND AROUND THE GLOBE. MR. O'LEARY JOINED THE ASSOCIATION IN MAY 2005 AS VICE PRESIDENT AND SENIOR COUNSEL FOR PUBLIC POLICY DEVELOPMENT. IN THAT CAPACITY, MR. O'LEARY WORKED CLOSELY WITH MPAA MEMBER STUDIOS TO DEVELOP A WIDE ARRAY OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY POLICIES AND STRATEGIES. MR. O'LEARY HAS NEARLY TWO DECADES OF

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY POLICY AND ENFORCEMENT EXPERIENCE. PRIOR TO JOINING THE MPAA, MICHAEL WAS DEPUTY CHIEF FOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY IN THE COMPUTER CRIME AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECTION (CCIPS) OF THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

MR. O'LEARY HAS PROSECUTED AND SUPERVISED SOME OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL, CRIMINAL INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY INVESTIGATIONS AND PROSECUTIONS EVER UNDERTAKEN. PRIOR TO JOINING THE CRIMINAL DIVISION, MR. O'LEARY SERVED FOR TWO YEARS IN THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT'S OFFICE OF LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS.

MR. O'LEARY STARTED HIS CAREER IN THE FIELD OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AS COUNSEL TO THE UNITED STATES SENATE COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY, WHERE HE SERVED FOR FIVE YEARS. WHILE ON THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, MR. O'LEARY ALSO SERVED AS CHIEF COUNSEL TO THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON THE CONSTITUTION.

MR. O'LEARY GREW UP IN MONTANA AND IS A GRADUATE OF ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA, SCHOOL OF LAW.
