AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1173
OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE OF NEW JERSEY

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3. OPPORTUNITY FOR THE CLASS INDEPENDENCE AD-**
2 **VISORY COUNCIL TO MEET AND RESPOND TO**
3 **HHS REPORT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2 shall not take effect
5 until the date that is 90 days after the Secretary of Health
6 and Human Services certifies to the Congress that all of
7 the following conditions are met:

8 (1) Members of the CLASS Independence Advi-
9 sory Council are appointed by the President, as re-
10 quired by section 3207(b)(1) of the Public Health
11 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 3001l-6(b)(1)).

12 (2) Such Council has conducted at least one
13 meeting.

14 (3) Such Council submits to the Secretary of
15 Health and Human Services and the Congress a re-
16 port that contains recommendations of the Council
17 that respond to the concerns raised in the report of
18 the Department of Health and Human Services enti-
19 tled “A Report on the Actuarial, Marketing, and

1 Legal Analyses of the CLASS Program” (October
2 2011).

3 (4) After submission of such report to the Con-
4 gress, Federal legislation is enacted addressing such
5 concerns.

6 (5) The Secretary of Health and Human Serv-
7 ices is implementing a national voluntary insurance
8 program for purchasing community living assistance
9 services and supports pursuant to such legislation.

10 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “CLASS
11 Independence Advisory Council” means the CLASS Inde-
12 pendence Advisory Council created under section 3207(a)
13 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ll–6(a)).
