PROPOSED MATTER FOR INCLUSION IN RECONCILIATION RECOMMENDATIONS

1 **TITLE II—MEDICAID**

2 **SEC. 201. REVISION OF PROVIDER TAX INDIRECT GUAR-** 3 **ANTEE THRESHOLD.**

4 Section 1903(w)(4)(C)(ii) of the Social Security Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 1396b(w)(4)(C)(ii)) is amended by inserting
6 “and for portions of fiscal years beginning on or after Oc-
7 tober 1, 2012,” after “October 1, 2011,”.

8 **SEC. 202. REBASING OF STATE DSH ALLOTMENTS FOR FIS-** 9 **CAL YEAR 2022.**

10 Section 1923(f) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
11 1396r-4(f)) is amended—

12 (1) by redesignating paragraph (9) as para-
13 graph (10);

14 (2) in paragraph (3)(A) by striking “para-
15 graphs (6), (7), and (8)” and inserting “paragraphs
16 (6), (7), (8), and (9)”; and

17 (3) by inserting after paragraph (8) the fol-
18 lowing new paragraph:

1 “(9) REBASING OF STATE DSH ALLOTMENTS
2 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022.—With respect to fiscal
3 2022, for purposes of applying paragraph (3)(A) to
4 determine the DSH allotment for a State, the
5 amount of the DSH allotment for the State under
6 paragraph (3) for fiscal year 2021 shall be treated
7 as if it were such amount as reduced under para-
8 graph (7).”.

9 **SEC. 203. REPEAL OF MEDICAID AND CHIP MAINTENANCE**
10 **OF EFFORT REQUIREMENTS UNDER PPACA.**

11 (a) REPEAL OF PPACA MEDICAID MOE.—Section
12 1902 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a) is
13 amended by striking subsection (gg).

14 (b) REPEAL OF PPACA CHIP MOE.—Section
15 2105(d)(3) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
16 1397ee(d)(3)) is amended—

17 (1) by striking subparagraph (A);

18 (2) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and
19 (C) as subparagraphs (A) and (B), respectively; and

20 (3) in the paragraph heading, by striking
21 “CONTINUATION OF ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS FOR
22 CHILDREN UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 2019” and inserting
23 “CONTINUITY OF COVERAGE”.

24 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

1 (1) Section 1902(a) of the Social Security Act
2 (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended by striking para-
3 graph (74).

4 (2) Effective January 1, 2014, paragraph (14)
5 of section 1902(e) (as added by section 2002(a) of
6 Public Law 111–148) is amended by striking the
7 third sentence of subparagraph (A).

8 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Except as provided in sub-
9 section (c)(2), the amendments made by this section shall
10 take effect on the date of the enactment of this section.

11 **SEC. 204. MEDICAID PAYMENTS TO TERRITORIES.**

12 (a) LIMIT ON PAYMENTS.—Section 1108(g) of the
13 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1308(g)) is amended—

14 (1) in paragraph (2)—

15 (A) by striking “paragraphs (3) and (5)”;

16 and

17 (B) by inserting “paragraph (3)” after
18 “and subject to”;

19 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking “(3), and”
20 and all that follows through “of this subsection” and
21 inserting “and (3) of this subsection”; and

22 (3) by striking paragraph (5).

23 (b) FMAP.—The first sentence of section 1905(b) of
24 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(b)) is amended

- 1 by striking “shall be 55 percent” and inserting “shall be
- 2 50 percent”.
